Why are we alive in this end time generation, if not to bear witness to the Lord Jesus Christ

nce our son Joshua gained access to the internet, he began to surprise Heidi and myself with unusual facts and figures, even reciting all the nations of the earth and the States in America, just because he could! Hunger to learn coupled with access to reliable resources is something that we would wish for every child on the earth, and for every Believer too. How blessed we are to have not just one Bible to hand, but various translations, not to mention the internet with excellent resources for those who don't know Hebrew or Greek.

It's this act of independent learning and seeking to understand, that I want to tackle today.

Now the fact that you're reading this 'Finest Hour' e-magazine, published from the desk of Mark Johnson is a pretty good indication that you also believe that we are living in the end of days, and consider yourself as part of an end time generation, who will usher in the return of our Lord Jesus. Don't our hearts yearn for Him to put an end to sin, to bring in everlasting righteousness, and for those incredible end time prophecies of old to be fulfilled?

Don't we hunger for the day the seventh angel will sound his trumpet, and when loud voices in heaven will declare:

Why are we alive in this end time generation, if not to bear witness to the Lord Jesus Christ, to contribute to the bowls of incense being filled through our prayers, and ultimately to join the voice of the Bride with the Spirit as they cry out, 'Come for Your Beloved Lord, Come for Your Bride'!

To recognise the signs of His return, and to bear witness and participate with all of heaven, we need wisdom and understanding, not merely intellectual understanding and certainly not worldy wisdom, but we need the Spirit of Wisdom and Understanding as in Isaiah 11. We need it by personal revelation from the Spirit of God through His Word to us as individuals, and not just corporately.

At the risk of throwing a cat amongst the pigeons here, we really need to stop simply listening to, and blindly following everything our favourite preacher or teacher says. Even if we absolutely love them, or even if their teaching is in this very e-magazine! Why? Because it's too easy to adopt another person's beliefs, without understanding it for ourselves.

I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better.

Ephesians 1:17

Sensationalism grabs headlines, and even Christian's eyes are turned towards the latest prophesies on Elijah List, or the latest Youtube video with an attention-seeking title. Not so for us, dear friends! It cannot be so! Come to the Word of God to gain wisdom and understanding, come to the Word made flesh, Jesus Himself, and dig deep, seek the diamonds hidden in the mine, and find the silver hidden therein in order to know Him.

If you truly call out to insight and lift your voice to understanding,

if you seek it like silver and search it out like hidden treasure, then you will discern the fear of the LORD

and discover the knowledge of God. Proverbs 2: 3-4

I don't seek to upset the apple cart, but have you ever asked why you believe what you believe, and does your opinion go alongside Scripture, or has Scripture been adapted, squeezed and shaped around your opinion? Many times, people's opinions are not founded in their own understanding of Scripture, but are we merely reiterating other people's teachings. This has been my discovery, as I examined the doctrine of pretribulation rapture. By referring primarily to the Olivet Discourse in Matthew 24, Mark 13 and Luke 21, and by referring to 1 & 2 Thessalonians, it is uncomplicated to reveal that (to quote my talk on the matter), the pretribulation rapture is a bucket full of holes. The words of Jesus tell us that we WILL go through the Great Tribulation, and Daniel tells us the same, as does the book of Revelation. There is no hidden or secret catching away before the return of Jesus.

How many Pastors who teach this theory would encourage their congregants to take time to study it for themselves? Isn't that what we should all be doing?

To quote Jesus, 'many will be deceived and the love of many will grow cold'. The quickest way to fall out of love with Jesus, is to become obsessed with something, or someone else, abandoning time with Him and cutting Jesus out of our day. I have said this before, but being obsessed with the vaccine is enough to take anyone out of relationship with Jesus, not to mention the division it can cause within families and friends. We have bigger fish to fry, and we need to keep our focus on what the Word says, and not falter to the left or the right.

I was quite a rebel before I came to Christ, I would challenge the status quo and think for myself. Since Christ has got a hold of me, the desire to pursue truth and to not simply conform has been a help. But equally, I like to think outside of the box. In hindsight I slightly pity my former Bible study leader who, during my 20's, would frequently be challenged through my straight talking debate, as I repeatedly questioned his beliefs. I was probably the thorn in his side, but equally, my questions hopefully deepened his resolve and understanding. The people from Berea mentioned in Acts 17:10-15 examined the Scriptures for themselves to see if the message they were receiving from Paul & Silas lined up with Truth. Great example for us to follow. Shouldn't we be pouring over the Scriptures to know Him better and for the Spirit of God to work within us, giving us His revelation, understanding, and wisdom?

Let's just look at the bigger picture again. There will be an 'End Time' be witnesses people who will throughout the world to the coming of our Lord. Wouldn't it be horrendous to miss the signs of His coming, because we're more obsessed with the latest vaccine, or we're hankering after the latest 'prophets' encouraging word that make us feel good? I expect I am talking to the converted here friends, but I spur all of us on to return to the Word of God with new vigour, hunger and desire to understand.

In my profession as a teacher here in the UK, I watched how independent learning disintegrated from the learnina process. Students were handed information sheets that they needed to memorise, with no research or independent learning required. The church is much the same, as we are digesting what we have been told, instead of independently studying the Word and discussing it. It's OK to listen to good Bible preachers and teachers, but it only should be to enhance our learning and not to replace it.

Persevere through disagreements

I remember a few years back I was challenged by a visitor to our church group, who vehemently and quite viciously slandered someone I held

dear and who I counted as a really good friend. I found myself feeling less and less 'Christian', and was inwardly reverting back to my younger days as a rugby player, and was about to suggest we take the conversation outside, when thank the Lord, my wife came to the rescue and diffused the situation. We in the Body of Christ have to grow up and if we don't agree with someone then be prepared to just walk away 'agreeing to disagree'. I have had many a battle on the rugby pitch within the confines of the game's rules (most of the time). They say that rugby is a hooligan's game played by gentlemen, and my experience is just that. Battles on the playing field would be followed by a respectable drink and chat together after the game. We may not have gone our separate ways liking each other, but we always parted respecting one another. As the body of Christ we can surely do better than that!

I love robust discussion over the Word. Iron sharpens iron. However, let's be humble and loving in our approach even when we disagree. More than simply trying to prove our point and be proven 'right', let's encourage and stimulate conversation to dig deeper into the Word and together find Truth, allowing ourselves to 'think outside the box', and not look at end time prophecy from a purely academic or historical perspective, but as the Holy Spirit to enlighten our imagination to better understand the scenarios that will play out, potentially before our very eyes.

Gain Wisdom & Understanding

I love studying Biblical end time prophecy, and asking the Lord to show me how things might play out in our life time. I have realised more and more how the body of Christ desperately needs to gain wisdom and understanding, in order to participate with the next move of God. Why? Daniel tells us.

Those who have insight will shine

brightly like the brightness of the expanse of heaven, and those who lead the many to righteousness, like the stars forever and ever.

Daniel 12: 3 (NASB)

Those who are wise shall shine Like the brightness of the firmament, And those who turn many to righteousness Like the stars forever and ever. Daniel 12:3 (NKJV)

Or look at the Sons of Issachar:

of the sons of Issachar who had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do, their chiefs were two hundred; and all their brethren were at their command; 1 Chronicles 12:32

Let's look at Moses and Aaron, who told Pharaoh what was to come, while also letting the Israelites know what was coming next. Pre-warned is pre-armed. When Moses told the people to cover the door posts with the blood of a lamb, they did it. Why? Because they had seen that Moses and Aaron had been right thus far so they began to realise that they had been sent by God to bring them out of bondage and did what they were told. Likewise, when we see certain events coming we can declare it and prepare people, especially answering the 'why' as these events unfold. We have the treasure filled Scripture and we have the Holy Spirit, we are alive here and now for a reason, so we must 'get with it', and seek understanding.

Thought Provokers

Just look at what occurred in the Middle East these past months. The Lord drew my attention in particular to the following. I saw American advisers coming out of the White House telling us in the west that the Taliban were at least 90 days from Kabul. Then President Biden stated it would be 50 days, however the Taliban drove into Kabul in SEVEN days. Yes seven. From this experience I again realised just how close we are to the final seven years (seventieth week) as prophesied by Daniel. Utterly staggering.

I just remember how quickly ISIS took Ragga and then Mosel. Things are going to speed up with an increasing pace. We are seeing end time Biblical prophecy being played out before our very eyes. The Northern federation is setting up perfectly as Daniel 11 tells us it would. There will be war in the Middle East. Watch out for the Northern Kingdom going against the Southern Kingdom (Egypt). Isaiah 19 tells us what happens to Egypt. Their destruction and then their future restoration after the Lords return. The judgements of God will come against these geographical areas because Ezekiel, Zechariah, Malachi, Joel, Habakkuk and Isaiah all tell us so. I know this next statement may be controversial, but through my independent study of the Word I believe there will be an Islamic body of people that will eventually go against Israel, as Jesus quoted from the book of Daniel, "Therefore when you see the 'abomination of desolation,' spoken by Daniel the prophet, standing in the Holy Place" (whoever reads let him understand), "then let those who are in Judaea flee to the mountains."

That tells us four things.

1. There will be a third Temple built 2. It will be a 'Holy Place'. Why? Because Jesus says it is. (That's going to upset some of the body of Christ when daily sacrifices take place in the third Temple.) But what about the rest of the world? They will be incensed seeing this happen. We must prepare ourselves and others when we see this happen.

3. The rise of the Anti-Christ

4. A fleeing to the mountains. Daniel tells us some of those places in Daniel 11:41

From Daniel's writing, remembering that the Book of Daniel was focused on the Middle East, could he be telling us that the Anti-Christ will be Islamic? Isaiah tells us the area he will come from is Assyria. All from the Seleucid kingdom, the "little horn" out of Daniel 7:8. He will set up a federation of ten kingdoms, ten kings (Daniel 8:24) the ten toes out of Daniel 2:43. Just think about it. What modern day nations unite with a single hatred for Israel? This man of perdition will turn against Israel with such anger that will result in Zechariah 13:8-9 and 14:2. We must be prepared to be "light" when these events take place.

Why is it vital that we know the Word, from a Biblical prophetic perspective? Because we are going to see them with our own eyes as they play out before us. What are the 2300 days all about in Daniel 8:14? The prophecy of the 'Seventy Weeks'? (Daniel 10:24) Here it is folks. Daniel 11:32-33 tells us.

Those who do wickedly against the covenant he shall corrupt with flattery; but the people who know their God shall be strong, and carry out great exploits. And those of the people who understand shall instruct many; yet for many days they shall fall by sword and flame, by captivity and plundering.

The Truth About

ne of the most powerful truths l've learned in my years of walking with the Lord is so often overlooked or misunderstood that God's people become confused and weak in their Christian walk.

That truth has to do with faith. As we look at Hebrews 11:1-2, I want to quote the Lamsa Bible which is based on the Peshitta text or the Aramaic language.

"Now faith is the substance of things hoped for as it was the substance of things which have come to pass; and it is the evidence of things not seen. And in this way it became a testimony concerning the elders."

Hebrews 11:1-2

The question must be asked, 'what are we looking at or seeing?' We've all heard the expression by now that what you focus on you empower. The more you focus on any one thing, the greater influence that thing you are focusing on is empowered and activated in your life. Let me give you an example of how this works. Recently we were praying for an individual who was in need of healing. They were in pain and had not had any relief even though they had prayed and been prayed for.

As this individual began to share with me what was going on in their body I stopped them and asked them a simple question, "How will you know you are healed?"

At first they were confused. Then they responded, "well by faith."

I said that was reasonable, but what does faith look like? Now they were really confused. The individual had no answer to this.

Faith is a substance. What does it need to be formed in to as you begin to apply it? A new bone? Smooth skin with no more rash? New eyes? And the list goes on.

Here is the key. When you are standing in faith for something that you've

Shemitah and the Tribulation

I, God will command My blessing for you in the sixth year, and it will yield produce for three years

The Shemitah is a seven year period ending in a Sabbath year. The thought came to me to find out where we are in this 7 year cycle. To my surprise, I found that we have entered the Sabbath year on the 8th September 2021. The following scriptures outline what this year is all about.

Release of Debts

At the end of seven years you will make a release. And this is the manner of the release: to release the hand of every creditor from what he lent his friend; he shall not exact from his friend or his brother, because the time of the release for the Lord has arrived. Deuteronomy 15:1–2

During the Shemitah Sabbath year all outstanding debts between Jewish debtors and creditors are waived.

The Land Must Rest

For six years you shall sow your field, and for six years you shall prune your vineyard, and gather in its produce. But in the seventh year, the land shall have a complete rest, a Sabbath to the Lord; you shall not sow your field, you shall not prune your vineyard, nor shall you reap the aftergrowth of your harvest . . . And [the produce of] the Sabbath of the land shall be yours to eat for you, for your male and female servants, and for your hired worker and resident who live with you.

Leviticus 25:3-6

And if you should say, "What will we eat in the seventh year? We will not sow, and we will not gather in our produce!" I, God will command My blessing for you in the sixth year, and it will yield produce for three years. And you will sow in the eighth year, while still eating from the old crops. Until the ninth year, until the arrival of its crop, you will eat the old crop!

Leviticus 25:20-22

During the Shemitah Sabbath year, the residents of the Land of Israel must completely stop from cultivating their fields. They also relinquish personal ownership of their fields; whatever produce grows on its own is considered communal property, free for anyone to take.

Slaves set Free

When you acquire a Hebrew slave, he shall serve six years; in the seventh year he shall go free, without payment. If he came single, he shall leave single. If he had a wife, his wife shall leave with him. If his master gave him a wife, and she has borne him children, the wife and her children shall belong to the master, and he shall leave alone. But if the slave declares,

"I love my master, and my wife and children: I do not wish to go free," his master shall take him before Elohim. He shall be brought to the door or the doorpost, and his master shall pierce his ear with an awl; and he shall then remain his slave for life.

Exodus 20:2-6

During the Shemitah Sabbath year, all slaves are set free, but a slave may choose to become a bond slave.

As the world does not follow this mandate from the Lord, they come under a curse. The result of this curse will reap a world wide financial collapse, and probably a property market collapse.

Beginning of the Tribulation

What I find very interesting is the correlation of the Shemitah cycle and the tribulation. The Tribulation can only start on a new Shemitah year.

The next new Shemitah cycle begins on the 26th September 2022. Does this mean the Tribulation could begin around September 2022? We need to look at others scriptures and see if anything else correlates.

Israel Becomes a Nation

Now learn this lesson from the fig

tree (Israel): As soon as its branches become tender and sprout leaves, you know that summer is near. So also, when you see all these things, you will know that He is near, right at the door. Truly I tell you, this generation will not pass away until all these things have happened

Mathew 24:32-34

Israel (fig tree) became a nation on May 14th 1948. Jesus was saying this generation that was born after 1948, will see the return of Jesus. But how long is a generation?

Genesis 15:13-16	100 years
Psalm 90:10	70-80 years
Leviticus 25:8-17	50 years
Psalm 95:10	40 years

We have a few numbers depicting the length of a generation. We can discount 40 and 50 as they have past. Psalm 90 tells us 70-80 is a generation.

The days of our lives are seventy years; And if by reason of strength they are eighty years,

Psalm 90:10

Does that fit within the Shemitah time period. 70 years from 1948 takes us to 2018. Accounting for the extra 10 years, (80 years in a generation), takes us to 2028.

The next Shemitah cycle will end on 20th September 2029. While this is a year later than the 80 years, this time frame still fits into 100 & 120 years for a generation, as seen in Genesis 6 and 15.


