

A Powerful Spiritual Drink Doug Addison [Episode 254] October 12, 2022

Hey everybody, Doug Addison. Welcome to *Spirit Connection* podcast. It's October 12th, 2022, and I tell you, this is a special, special week. I'm so excited. I'm wearing my power red. It's a "power of the blood of Jesus" red shirt. This week is an opening up of one message I do once a year, usually, but there's something powerful happening on October 16th. But it doesn't matter when you listen to this because God's outside of time. He created time.

But Lord, we pray, open the anointing. Open the heavens and bring about what You originally did in John chapter seven. Open the heavens and give us a spiritual drink, in Jesus' name. Amen.

Anyway, I'm just distracted right now (sorry) because the power is so strong. God is definitely outside of time. I won't even—, I'll tell you later about my social media or just go to DougAddison.com. You'll see it there.

I just want to jump right into this. Listen, this is the time of year, it's called The Days of Awe. We've gone through the Jewish New Year. It doesn't matter. We're no longer under the Law of Moses. Listen, I don't celebrate the holidays. You know, I'm quite

Gentile, thank you. If you do, that's fine. But I'm just saying this is the time of year to hear the voice of God. And our assignment for the year is getting revealed.

Historically, October 16th, 2022, is this Sunday, and it ties right in with the New Testament, with John 7:37, "On the last ..." I'm just going to go jump right in because I want to release this anointing. But see, the greatest feast in Jesus' time—, He even said it in John 7, John7:37. He sets this up and he said, "On the last and greatest day of the feast ..." (which this Sunday, October 16th, is that day). However, again, God's outside of time. Remember, we're no longer under the Law of Moses. He created time.

So, I'm just going to bring you right into it on the last day. This is John 7:37, "And the greatest day of the Feast of Tabernacles, Jesus stood and said in a loud voice (He yelled), 'Let anyone who is thirsty come to me and drink. And whoever believes in me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow within them and from them." So, this is a powerful, powerful week or whenever. If you want to just tap into this any time, I tell you, whenever, I need a drink from the Lord, I just pull in this Scripture of John 7:37:

Lord, we pray for that drink of spiritual water.

Jesus said, He said that you can get living water to run over you, and He's talking about Himself, you know. And we have that through a relationship with Him, through the Holy Spirit.

But as You open our assignments ...

That's what's going on right now during the Days of Awe. But, you know, I don't know if you understand it or not, but Rosh Hashanah was the Jewish New Year. Then we had Yom Kippur just last week, which is the opening up of things. And then this whole week, we've been working through this time of the Feast of Tabernacles. You know, I don't do anything except listen to the Lord.

But we pray for that living water to open up our assignments, that You're doing things right now. In Jesus' name.

Well, you can look it up. But the Hoshana Rabbah is the last day of the feast, and I'm going to move right in a little bit more. In John 7, Jesus goes to the Feast of Tabernacles. So, this is where He brings this in. Remember, we are outside of time. So, God created [time], but also, we're no longer, you know, legalistic in the sense that we have to do this on a certain day. We have to do certain things. You can pull on this any time, but I'm going to tell you that it was the last day of this feast in John 7. So, I'm going to back it up (John 7) to bring the context and to open up the angels that come with this.

And so, in John 7:1, "And after this, Jesus went around in Galilee, and he did not want to go up to Judea because the Jewish leaders were looking for him to kill him." So, here He's got a bunch of people. You ever feel like that, you know, you're under a lot of attack and you just wanna, like, hang low. Jesus was like that right there. But He wanted to wait on the Lord. In verse two, "But when the Jewish Feast of Tabernacles was near, Jesus' brothers said to him, 'Leave Galilee and go to Judea with your disciples ...'" They were already there because everyone was celebrating that week. And he says, "... that way they can see all the works you do."

They were trying to help Him, you know. But he's like—, in verse four, "But no one who wants to become a public figure acts in secret" they said to Him. He says, "The things ... show yourself to the world." Verse five, "And even his own brothers did not believe in him." So, in other words, in verse six watch this ... Jesus says this, "Therefore he says to them, 'My time is not yet come; and for you any time will do." Verse eight—, I'm going to skip a verse there for context, you can read it later, but verse eight, "You go to the festival. I'm not going to the festival, because my time has not yet come." Now, his time has not yet come to show himself to the world or to go to the festival.

Instead of using human wisdom and advice, Jesus pulls back, and He got the wisdom of the Lord's timing.

In John 7:10, "However, after this, his brothers had left to go to the festival, but he also went, but not publicly, so he went in secret." And I just want to just release this to you. He waited on the Lord, He waited on the Father, and then He went, and He did some things in secret. I do this a lot. I tell you, I'm trying to move in this time right now.

God wants to give you secret strategies. In fact, that was in my podcast last week about Matthew 13. Jesus says, "For the knowledge of the secrets of the kingdom of heaven have been given to you, but not to the world." And so in John 7:14 (let's keep going), "Not until halfway through the festival did Jesus go up to the temple courts and begin to preach. And then the Jews are all amazed, and said, 'Man, how is he so learned without being taught?" God wants to use supernatural impartation with you, now you know you don't have to get up and preach. You don't have to stand out on the corner or anything. You don't have to do that.

But I'm just saying, you have everything that you need. The Lord has equipped you. Your spirit is strong right now. You can do all the things through Christ, who gives you strength. You're seated with Christ in heavenly places.

Now, the last day of the feast, you know, it's called Hoshana Rabbah, and that's actually on October 16. But again, you can tap into this. You can actually do—, I recommend doing some communion in a group or a couple of people (or by yourself) and ask the Lord for this. And then when He finally released the Spirit in John 7:37 on—, I'm read it again, He says, "On the last and the greatest day of the festival, Jesus stood and said with a loud voice, 'Let anyone who is thirsty come to me and drink. And whoever drinks in me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from them."

Lord, we pray right now that You would release that drink of whatever it might be. (Some people, you might need a refreshment. You know, maybe you're tired. Man, I tell you, I've been under a lot of, you know, just a lot of attack, of warfare. But you know what? I get filled all the time with this. Well, maybe you need a refreshment in the area of wisdom and understanding ... or love.) Lord, release what it is that we all need (each person needs something different), in Jesus' name.

Now, here's how to open your ability to see spiritually. This goes right with—, I'm going to do a couple of steps, and I just wrote this out. It's not like it's a formula, but I put some steps down that you can use, that I use to open up to see spiritually.

Step one. First of all, confess your sins and ask God to reveal things needing attention. Now, this is not to beat you up or anything like that, but Psalm 139:23, "Search me O God and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts ..." Now you can get rid of anxiety, even, here. "... See if there's an offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting."

Lord, I confess anything I've done right now. (Maybe you have some things that you repeat. You know I had for years. You know, no one's perfect. Don't let that keep you from the Lord. If you're struggling with addictions or you got stuff going on, confess it daily if you have to, but just stay in there.) Lord, I confess, anything that I know of or anything, that's knowingly or unknowingly. And I ask You to search my heart and show me if there's anything hidden that's offensive. And I thank You for Your grace. And we bring this to the cross of Christ. We bring this under the blood of Jesus.

First John 1:9 says, "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." Wahoo! How good is that? Then you go even

further. "And the prayer of a righteous man or woman is powerful and effective." I forgot where that is, but I remember that goes with it. So, you just confess each day.

Step two is: take your position in Christ. Galatians 3:27, "I am clothed in Christ." Ephesians 2:6, "And God, who raised up Jesus Christ, has seated us with him in heavenly places ... in the realms with Jesus." Now, if you're in a realm of a—, maybe you're in a realm of addiction or realm around you of anxiety, just go right now. Let that breath of the Lord bring you up to be seated with Christ right now in heavenly places, you don't have to be in Heaven. I'm just saying your spirit's connected, not your body, your soul; your spirit's connected.

Lord, I'm now standing clothed in Your authority. And now my spirit is seated with You, in Jesus' name.

Now whether you feel it or not, God's there with you.

Here's another one. I'm higher—, I tell you, the Lord bring me this, "I'm higher and above everything coming against me on Earth" (Ephesians 1:21). Also, "No weapon formed against me will prosper," in Jesus' name. If you know who you are, that's going to make a huge, huge difference.

Now, decree and communion. "Lord, I decree …" Decreeing is basically taking a Bible verse or a promise and making it, you know, a declaration over you. Ephesians 1:18—I'm going to decree with you right now "that the eyes of your understanding will be enlightened that you may understand and know the hope of your calling and the riches of His glory in their inheritance of the saints."

Also, I decree right now in Revelation 3:20, "Here I am!" the Lord says, "I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and them with me."

Now, this is a time the Lord is moving. This would be a good time to take communion. I normally have it. I don't have any. I came in from a trip right away, wanted to record this to get this going. Normally, I have communion, but I'll just take a drink of water to show you. You can pray over everything. We just pray, "Lord, that whatever we do—." If you can take communion right now, it's the body and the blood of Jesus. Or the drink of the living water. There's nothing magic about it. We're praying over it and making it holy.

Now step four is to ask the Lord to speak to you.

Lord, I pray that You would cause our eyes to be open. (Like last week's podcast, I talk about Matthew 13, that He wants to open your eyes, your ears, and give you a heart of understanding—spiritual eyes that see ears here and a heart that understands.) So, open discernment, open our senses that we would know, open our ability ... mostly, the biggest thing is to love.

And step five: I thought it was only four, but there's actually five. Write down what you're hearing. Record it down. Now I'm going to do this prayer over you, over your finances or over whatever it is you need because it really works. Deuteronomy 28:12, "Lord, open ..." Wow. Here it comes. [chuckles] Whoo! It was a wave. I had to wait for it. Wait for the ... I just waited on the Lord.

Now, Lord, open to you the good treasures of Heaven. And give us a rain in our land in its season. And bless the work of our hands.

Now I'm just saying a decree way. You know, I'm decreeing. I'm just paraphrasing it just a bit. The actual one is, "The Lord will open his good treasures over you. He will give you rain in your land and he will bless the work of your hand that you shall lend to many

and borrow from none" (Deuteronomy 28:12). And I'm not changing the meaning, but I put it more personal. That's a decree.

Lord, open the storehouses and let it flow over us.

There's a release of financial blessing right now to help a hurting world or to help you if you're hurting. The Lord knows this. He wants to open up things on how to hear God for your breakthrough plan. I've been talking about this. Isaiah 5:19. This is The Passion Translation, "Let the prophetic plan of the Holy One of Israel come to pass quickly that we may see it, what it is!"

This is the time of year the Lord wants to release your prophetic plan. He's shown me some things.

We're in need. In fact, we've been raising funds. Linda and I, we're coming out of a seven-year—, we've been going 21 years. InLight Connection, 21 years. Man, we poured it in, we've poured it over and over and over. But we're coming out of a seven-year assignment here in Los Angeles. And, you know, to see behind the scenes of the Seven Mountains. I know some stuff ... I mean, I know things that the Lord—, you know, healing strategies and stuff that we can do, and I have to have time, you know, to actually come out of this intense time that Linda and I, we've been ... we poured everything into it. But we need, we need time to write and do some things.

And so, we're actually doing a celebration right now and you can go to DougAddison.com/Celebrate because we are ... we've been celebrating our 21st year. InLight Connection, we started our ministry 21 years ago, two weeks after 9/11. The Lord called us to do this, and we did a lot of different things. We planted churches. We're now on the internet and I speak occasionally, but this is a time right now the Lord wants to do this. And, you know, if my ministry has blessed you, the *Daily Prophetic* or

my *Spirit Connection* podcast each week, my blog, we have been pouring it in and pouring it in.

The Lord told me there's a plan that we need right now. Linda and I, we've sown. I'll just tell you straight up, we're 63. I'm 63 and Linda's 64. When most people should be retiring, we just we gave (or sowed) a half a million in rent to live here. We don't live in a mansion [chuckles], but half a million of our money of rent to live in the place for the last seven years that the Lord showed us to live. And this is the place where I am right now. But it's time to move on. And the Lord wants to just—, He just wants to open this up. And so, there's so much where I'll be putting out some more videos on the healing strategies that I've gotten here, some things about the Seven Mountains, the things to help you to understand that God is totally in control.

I mean, He is ... He's totally in charge. Everything's going to be okay.
